

## **Attention parents of Incoming 6th graders**

### **Information about registration for Before and After School (ASES) program**

Our ASES program is **free of charge**, funded by a state grant, and has attendance requirements for all participating students. ASES is offered before and after school every day that school is in session.

#### **Before-School Program:**

Program hours are Mon-Fri 6:30am-8:30am. Students are expected to check-in before 7:29 am four days a week to meet attendance requirements. **Hour may vary but additional info will be sent accordingly.**

#### **After-School Program:**

After School Program hours are 3:15pm-6:15pm. To meet attendance requirements students must stay signed in until 4:45pm five days a week. **Hour may vary but additional info will be sent accordingly.**

Registration for 2017-2018 ASES program for incoming 6th graders will take place, Monday, April 24 – Friday April 28 from 4:30pm to 6:00pm in room 103. (The forms are **not** available online or in the front office of our school.)

**Due to our extensive waiting list, we will once again be holding a lottery for the 60 available slots for the after-school program. Students with a form that has been completed by Friday, April 28 will be entered into the lottery, which will take place on Monday, May 1<sup>st</sup>. We will notify parents the week of May 1<sup>st</sup> if your child has been selected, or where they stand on the waiting list. There is not a lottery for the morning program. However, be sure to sign up for the morning program during this registration period since we were full when school began this year.**

Any registration forms received after April 28 (6:00 PM) will be placed on the waiting list for the 2017-2018 school year.. Unfortunately, we cannot take any special circumstances into account as we fill our limited slots. We are trying to be as fair as possible to all families.
