Attention 6th grade families. Has your child received the Tdap vaccination? Proof of immunization is the first step of our registration process. All you need to do is make a copy of the immunization record and drop it by the health office or you can scan and email it to: jewilson@powayusd.com. I recommend you schedule a doctor appointment right away if your student hasn't been vaccinated as appointments book up quickly if you wait until August. Students will not be allowed to register for 7th grade or attend classes until proof of vaccination is provided.

Parents, I need your help for this reminder. I understand the difficulty in scheduling appointments for your children, but when possible we really appreciate you avoiding checking your child out during lunch. Unfortunately, kids often forget to come to the office requiring us to try to find them out on campus. With 600 students out at the same time, this is often like trying to find a needle in a haystack. This will help us to do a better job of getting them to you in a timely manner.
